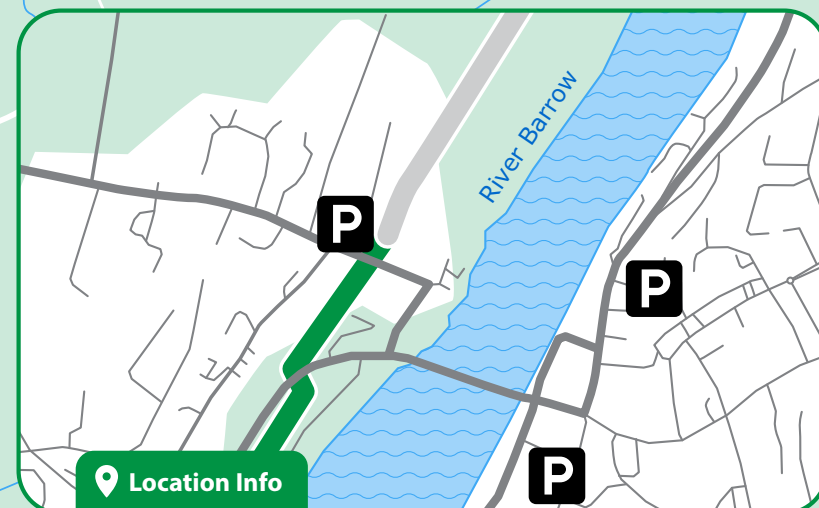

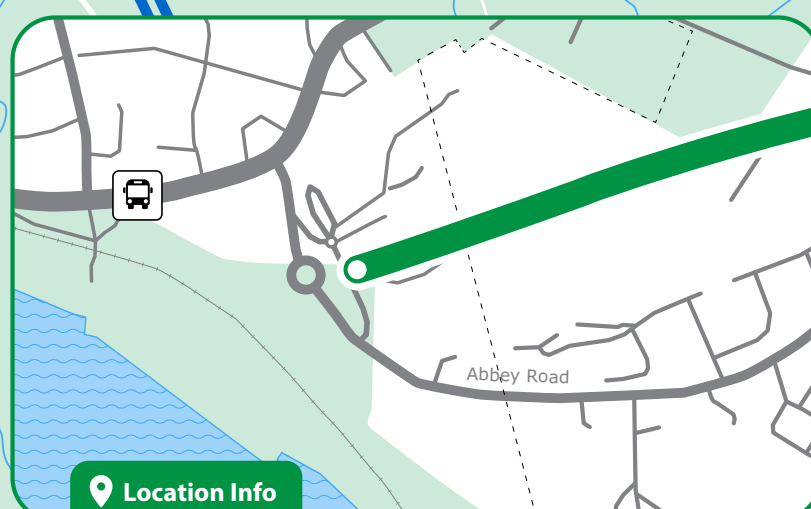

New Ross to Glenmore

6 km

The greenway starts at the old rail yard in Rosbercon on the western side of New Ross. There are bike and car parking spaces as well as a picnic area and seating.

Heading south, you will leave the town of New Ross as the route quickly becomes secluded – at times the route travels adjacent to the river offering lovely waterside views. The route ends at Glenmore just north of the Rose Fitzgerald Kennedy bridge. There is a trailhead at this location with plentiful bike and car parking spaces.

3-4

Curraghmore to Ferrybank

7 km

This southern section of the greenway opened in June 2026 and provides connectivity from Curraghmore to Ferrybank which is situated near to the North Quays in Waterford City.

This route features historic stones bridges and runs through an agricultural landscape passing directly by the Rhu Glenn Hotel – a major live music and community hub for wider region. Construction works are ongoing on the North Quays project until 2028 – when completed, these works will facilitate direct connectivity into the city centre for walkers and cyclists via a new dedicated bridge.
