



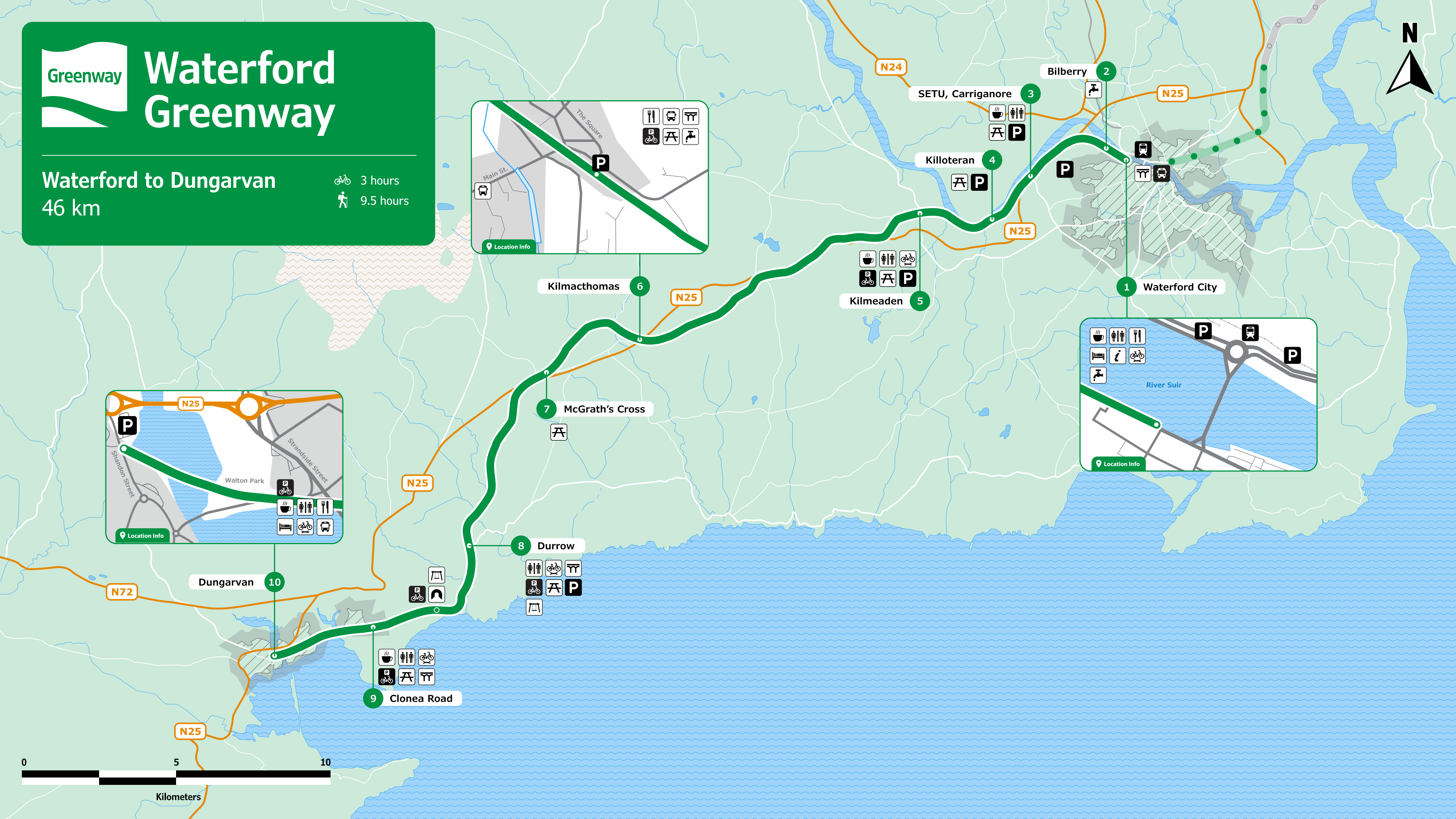
Waterford Greenway

Waterford to Dungarvan

1-5 Waterford City to Kilmeaden 10.5 km

The Greenway begins on the city's South Quays in Ireland's oldest city, winding through the city's outskirts along the River Suir into the countryside. Highlights include views of the historic Red Iron Bridge, the Thomas Francis Meagher Bridge, the Woodstown Viking site, Mount Congreve Gardens and the Waterford Suir Valley heritage train at Kilmeaden. This first leg is flat and family friendly, with parking and services available.

5-6 Kilmeaden to Kilmacthomas 13.5 km

Leaving the old railway station at Kilmeaden, this rural section offers fine views of the Comeragh Mountains. Arriving into Kilmacthomas, the route passes the old workhouse which now hosts a bike hire business and cafe. You have the option to divert into Kilmacthomas village. Kilmacthomas, at the midpoint of the Greenway, offers cafés, a playground, and the impressive 19th-century viaduct.

6-8 Kilmacthomas to Durrow 12 km

Heading west, the Greenway passes under the N25 national road at McGrath's Cross. The route crosses the impressive Durrow Viaduct, built in 1878, which crosses the River Tay. As you approach Durrow, you'll pass the old railway station and signal box. As well as a dedicated trailhead at Durrow, there is also a playground located adjacent to the route.

8-10 Durrow to Dungarvan 10 km

Shortly after leaving Durrow, you enter the atmospheric 400 metre Ballyvoyle Tunnel with ferns and overhanging trees creating a magical stretch. Not long after the tunnel, you will cross the final viaduct which offers serene views out over the River Dalligan valley. Soon, you will begin to smell the fresh sea-air and glimpse your first views of the picturesque strand at Clonea. The trail concludes in Walton Park in Dungarvan town, where you can enjoy its castle, museum, restaurants, pubs and waterfront.
