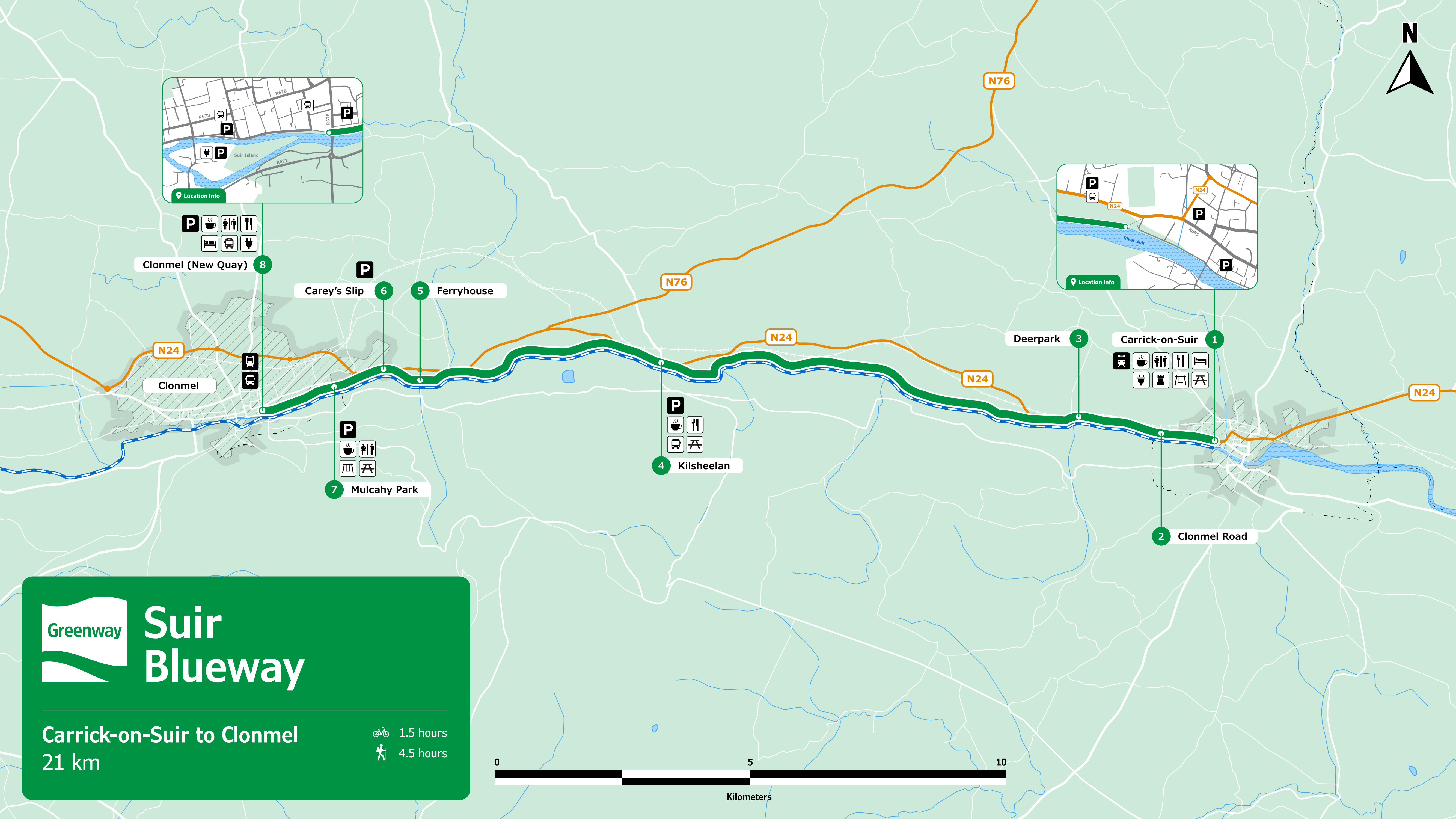




1-4 Carrick-on-Suir to Kilsheelan 11.5 km

You set off from Seán Healy Park in Carrick on Suir on the western side of the town along the scenic northern bank of the River Suir. The River Suir is best known for its salmon and brown trout evidenced by the many fisherman huts you will pass on your travels.

This stretch of the blueway passes the historic sites such as Davin's Weir and Tower, Glyn Castle and Poulakerry Castle. The route does narrow from a width of 3 meters to 2 meters in some sections. As you approach Kilsheelan, you will see the striking Kilsheelan Bridge, this is a three-arched bridge erected around 1820.

4-5 Kilsheelan to Ferryhouse 6.5 km

You can opt to take a break and refreshments at Kilsheelan Village where you can explore the adjacent Kilsheelan Graveyard with the ruin of the old 12th century church, featuring an Irish Romanesque carved stone doorway, fronted by a beautiful river garden. The village also features a Norman motte.

Continuing your journey on the greenway, you will pass historical sites including Killaloan Church and Tikincor Castle with the Comeragh mountains looming to the south of the river. After passing under Sir Thomas' bridge, you will find yourself alongside Bulmers apple orchard. Bulmers have been established in Clonmel since 1935.

5-8 Ferryhouse to Clonmel 3 km

You can avail of a rest at Carey's Slip seats before your final approach into Clonmel. Mulcahy Park incorporates a large childrens playground just off the greenway and plenty of green space and seating to relax and enjoy the peace of the blueway.

The final 1.5 kilometers steadily brings you into a more urban environment and the route ends at the car park located after the Gas House Bridge, a 19th century five-arch bridge. Clonmel is a large town with plenty to offer visitors in terms of sites of interest, accommodation and refreshment options.
