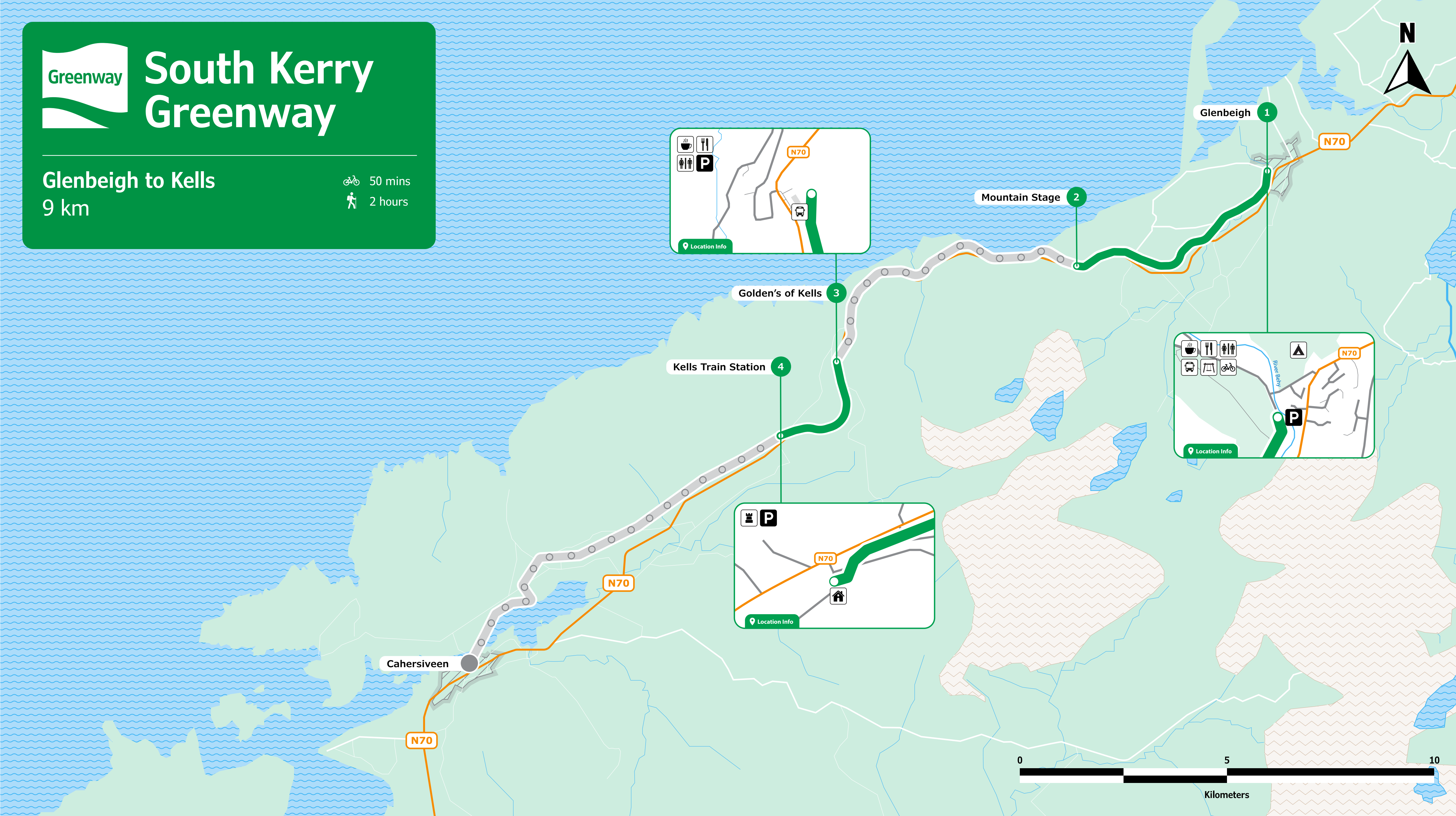




South Kerry Greenway

Glenbeigh to Kells 9 km

1-2 Curra Road, Glenbeigh to Mountain Stage 6 km

This section begins at Curra Road near Glenbeigh and runs for 6 km to Mountain Stage. The route starts along a quiet woodland corridor on Curra Hill, offering a peaceful and sheltered setting. It then continues for a short stretch along Curra Road as a designated 'quiet road', before returning to a fully off-road greenway.

From here, users can take in views of the surrounding landscape, including the Coolroe and Beenreagh mountains. The route crosses the former Curra Railway bridge before continuing on to Mountain Stage.

Works are ongoing on the next phase of the greenway to open in June 2026. At present, this section ends in a cul-de-sac, and users should return along the same route.

3-4 Golden's of Kells to Kells Train Station 3 km

This section of the greenway runs from Golden's of Kells to just beyond the former Kells Train Station, along the historic Farranfore to Valentia Harbour railway line. The route is fully surfaced and easy to use, making it suitable for walkers and cyclists of all abilities.

It offers spectacular views across Kells Bay and the Atlantic Ocean, placing visitors right in the heart of the Skellig Coast — one of the most scenic parts of the Iveragh Peninsula.

Temporary parking is available at both Golden's of Kells and the former train station, providing convenient access to the route.
